1. Entry is free. 2. One entry per person, per category. Please bring along your completed entry form, one per category with you on the day. 3. All cakes must be brought to the Town Council table, at the Castle Site on June 5<sup>th</sup> and registered between 2pm and 3pm. 4. The cake competition will be judged at 3.30pm. 5. All cakes will be cut and tasted. 6. All cakes must be made to food hygiene regulations, safe for consumption & be **NUT FREE**. 7. Judging will be carried out on the day and the Judges' decision is final. 8. Cakes will be judged on taste & appearance, the 6 cupcakes on originality, design and taste. 9. There will be one prize per category for each age group. 10. Winners will be announced between 4.30pm and 5pm on the day. 11. If you would like your cake back after the competition, please collect it by 5.30pm at the latest, otherwise it will be donated to raise funds for charity. 12. If you are a winner you consent to us taking your photo and using it in the future for promotional material, such as our website and social media. 13. Queenborough Town Council will not keep or share your personal details, and they will be securely disposed of at the end of the event.
