Whilst Councillors supported the principal development, they had concerns that this should be in moderation with the existing building. Transport concerns re public transport with regards the Town Council's concerns raised to the local plan consultation, due to the lack of public

transport facilities in the area. The general feeling was that the development should be like for like as only two houses with parking for two cars per household due to the current parking situation in the area.
