



Gas Network Upgrade – B2007 Main Road, Queenborough

We're preparing to carry out essential gas network upgrades in the Main Road area of Queenborough. This work will ensure a continued safe and reliable supply of gas is delivered to nearby homes and businesses. This is part of our 30-year programme of work to replace our old mains, reaching the end of their useful lives, with new, reliable plastic pipe.

Our contractor, WCB Utilities, who are completing this project on our behalf, will be starting work in the week beginning 2 September.

To ensure everyone's safety, we'll need to close the following roads around our work site while we have excavations open.

- **Phase 1 - B2007 Main Road** – from 2 September with an estimated end date of 14 October. We'll be working from the junction with Sterling Road to the junction with A249 Brielle Way. The closure point will change as we move along the road. We'll also need to have the following roads temporarily closed at their junctions with Main Road as we pass by; Sterling Road, Harold Street, Stanley Avenue and Borough Road.
- **Phase 2 - A250 Queenborough Road** – Once work is completed on phase one, our engineers will begin work on Queenborough Road. We estimate this will take approximately three to four weeks to complete. We'll be working at the junction with A250 Main Road. We will also have a lane closure in Place on A250 Main Road while Queenborough Road is closed.

Signed diversions will be in place for affected motorists where roads are closed. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses.

We're writing to residents and other local stakeholders to explain the details of this work. This letter can be shared with anyone you feel may have an interest in our work.

We understand roadworks can be frustrating. However, the new plastic pipe has a lifespan of 80 years. This means that once our work is done, Queenborough residents and businesses will be able to enjoy the benefits of a safe and reliable supply of gas for many years to come.
